The Department has decided upon a schedule of salaries
to be paid to officers and employees of the Immigration Service, as
follows:

Promotions to \$1400, \$1600 and \$1800 per annum.

Messengers,-----	" "	840	" "

Laborers,-----	" "	720	" "
Charwomen (when continuously employed)"	" "	720	" "

The salaries of inspectors in charge will be determined by
the Department, upon the basis of the relative responsibility in the
administration of the various stations.

Promotions will be made strictly upon merit and not because
of length of service. The efficiency ratings which will be prepared
in conformity with the requirements of Bureau Circular No. 19 (about
to be issued) will have an important bearing upon the matter of mak-
ing promotions.
