Receipt is acknowledged of Bureau letter of the 27th instant, No. 53108/22, with which was transmitted a supply of notice No. 54, issued by the Civil Service Commission, announcing a special examination for the position of mounted inspector in the Immigration Service, such examination being scheduled for February 8th, 1911.

The notice referred to will be properly distributed through this District and the widest publicity possible will be given to the announcement.

In this connection it is desired to inform the Bureau that considerable interest has already been manifested in this immediate community in connection with the announcement, which was posted in the federal building at this place several days ago, and it now seems likely that a large register of applicants will be obtained.

The Bureau's suggestion that a list of eligibles of sufficient proportions ^{is desired} to give some matter in the choice of selection is heartily endorsed by this office, and it is believed that such list will be secured.
