Pending legislation provides for a land border patrol and makes available a sum in excess of the regular appropriation which may be expended for that and other purposes.

It is believed that the smount appropriated is sufficient to effectually put a stop to all smuggling operations along the land boundaries, which is the purpose of the legislation in question, and with that end in view you are directed to furnish the Bureau with an estimate, by wire, of the number of guards, or patrolmen, (confining your wire to this class of employees), required in your district to successfully patrol the border, taking into consideration the success of such operations rather than the smount involved, as all officers concerned will be held accountable for the results accomplished in their respective districts.

It is proposed to provide exployees of the nature mentioned with modes of conveyance, where necessary, and in a written communication you are directed to go more thoroughly into a discussion of the needs of your district in that particular respect, outlining the points within your District at which guards, or patrolmen, should be stationed, it being thought advisable in some instances that such employees travel in pairs. In this latter connection, suggestions covering all phases of smuggling prevention work in your District are requested by the Dureau. (Signed) W. W. SIERAY


