Respectfully referring to your letter of the 29th ultimo, and as directed in a communication, addressed to him, Mr. Willard F. Kelly, 127 Winooski Avenue, Burlington, Vermont, appeared at this office, this date, and was duly interviewed by the undersigned.

Mr. Kelly is 31 years of age, married, no children, height 5'10", weight 150 lbs. Has been, for the past six months, District Sales Manager of the Federal Pure Food Co., Burlington, Vt. Two years previously was in the employ of the United Fruit Company, as third steward, on one of the boats of that company, and while in such service had considerable experience in the care of deportees, and to prevent ineligibles from landing at American ports. Has no knowledge of Immigration Law. Has had some experience with motorcycle. States that recent medical examination showed him to be physically fit.

Mr. Kelly appears quick and intelligent, and it is considered that he would be a desirable acquisition to the Patrol Service.
