We have your letter of the 2nd. It was a typographical error in saying blue uniform collar.

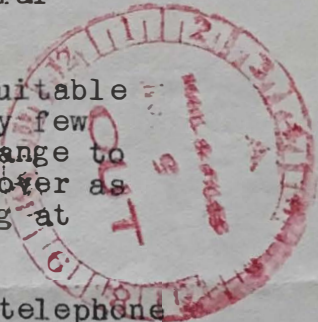
