Referring further to the Bureau's letter of the 12th instant, No. 55423/660, and supplementing letters of this office in reply thereto dated the 17th, 20th and 24th instants, there is enclosed copy of report from the Patrol Inspector in Charge of the Arizona Patrol Subdistrict, from which it will be observed that no patrol inspectors in that area have ordered uniforms of the character referred to in the Bureau's letter above mentioned.

This is the final report in the premises and, in connection with previous reports furnished, establishes conclusively that no patrol inspector in this immigration district has ordered a uniform of the character mentioned in the Bureau's letter above cited, and that no patrol inspector, with the exception of Motor Mechanic (Acting Patrol Inspector) Charles W. Bowman, recently transferred to Detroit, has even made an effort to secure such a uniform.
