The Bureau is forwarding to you today, by parcel post,
the following quantities of braid for uniforms of border patrol
officers in your district:

INSIGNIA OF RANK:

3 yards silver braid, 1/4" wide, for 16 senior patrol inspectors.
26 inches gold braid, 3/8" wide, for 4 chief patrol inspectors.
13 inches gold braid, 3/8" wide, for 1 assistant superintendent.

INSIGNIA INDICATING LENGTH OF SERVICE:

1 yd. 3 in. silver braid, 1/4" wide, for 31 patrol inspectors.
20 inches silver braid, 1/4" wide, for 16 senior patrol inspectors.
5 inches gold braid, 1/4" wide, for 4 chief patrol inspectors.
1 1/4 inches gold braid, 1/4" wide, for 1 assistant superintendent.

NOTE: 1/4" is allowed on each strip for turning under of edges.

One-quarter inch silver braid has been substituted for
3/8" silver braid for insignia of rank of senior patrol inspectors.
