

The following are the scores of Charles Askins Jr., at Camp Perry, Ohio, 1925, while a member of the 8th Corps Area Rifle Team.

1. Citizens Military Training Camps Championship Match.

200 yds. off hand	-	45
200 yds rapid	-	44
300 yds. "	-	43

This match was shot by a team of 10 men and was won by the team on which Askins shot.

2. Leech Cup Match - Individual Match. Prone.

800 yds - 7 shots; 900 yds - 7 shots; 1000 yds - 7 shots
Askins score was 102 out of a possible 105 which gave him 7th place in the match.

3. Navy Match, Ind. Match.

20 shots off hand, 200 yds, made 90 out of possible 100.
Place in match unknown, but a score of 96 usually wins this match.

4. Presidents' Match, Ind. Match.

10 shots at 200 yds off hand; 10 shots prone at 600 yds; and, 20 shots prone at 1000 yds.
In this match medals are given to the first hundred men, Askins took 42nd place.

5. Wimbledon Match, Ind. Match.

20 shots at 1000 yds prone, Askins made 92.
Score of 100 generally wins.

6. Port Clinton Match, Team of 6 men.
C.M.T.C. 8th Corps Area Team, 14th place.
7. National Pistol Team Match,
Position in match unknown.
8. National Individual Pistol Match.
Position in match unknown.
9. Graduate of Camp Perry Small Arms Firing School.
10. Holds two legs on Distinguished Rifleman's Medal,
three legs being necessary to possess this medal.
This medal is the highest award given by the government
to riflemen.
