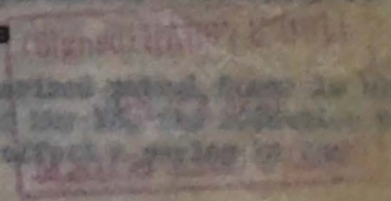

Referring to 1 Motor Mechanic 55409/1 of February 29, 1931 I beg to refer 1 Clerk all Service papers relating to George H. Page of New Troy, Vt., a candidate for appointment as Patrol Inspector. I am also enclosing Department letter No. 2301 of recent date Motor Equipment that this man is already appointed for appointment as a patrol inspector, and it would seem that his 6-Cars should be filed with the Civil Service Commission, in order that he may be barred for appointment to any position under the government.

An additional car will be provided for the Island Pond unit, and authority to solicit bids for the purchase of same is being issued in another letter of this date.

The foregoing allocation provides for one additional clerk at Newport, in lieu of the laborer position previously authorized for the Massena sub-district. higher than the allocation for Ireland. Mr. Ireland is well and favorably located in You will note that your total authorized patrol force is 106 instead of 108, as stated in Bureau letter of May 15, the reduction of two inspectors having been made in order to effect a saving in the annual salary obligation.
