The Bureau is indeed gratified at the interest shown by our patrol officers throughout the Service in the care and use of firearms, and it is hoped that this interest will not be permitted to lag, for the reason that it is contemplated to arrange for a limited number of patrol officers from the various patrol districts to attend the Small Arms School at Camp Perry in 1932 and probably participate in the subsequent pistol and rifle matches. Attendance at this school during this year was considered inadvisable due to the economical situation.
