A BILL

To establish the United States Border Patrol, to regulate the entry of persons into the United States, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
That this Act may be cited as the "Border Patrol Act, 1930."

SEC. 2. (a) There is hereby established in the Department of the Treasury an organization to be known as the United States Border Patrol. In order to secure close cooperation between the patrols along the land and water boundaries of the United States the United States Border Patrol
