- Silver bullion or silver braid, 1/4" in width - - - - - 8 yards *sent*
- Gold bullion or gold braid, 1/4" in width - - - - - 2 yards *sent*
- Stars of silver bullion, 1/2" from point to point - - - 100
- Stars of gold bullion, 1/2" from point to point - - - 36
