There is also attached hereto an inventory of uniform equipment as of April 1, 1933, such report containing all necessary information for the files of the Bureau in regard to the movement of uniform equipment in the Canadian Border District between May 1, 1932, and April 1, 1933.

It will be noted that reports of the Marcus Sub-district are missing. These will be forwarded as soon as received, the delay being due to a shortage of forms at the Marcus office.
