

Having reference to Central Office No. 55751/676, letter of July 6th, there is forwarded herewith a copy of the report submitted by the Chief Patrol Inspector at Tampa, Florida, under date of the 30th ultimo, No. 522/A, covering the Third Annual Pistol and Revolver Matches held at Tampa, Florida, July 16, 17 and 18, 1934.

It will be noted from the report that Police officers of Miami, Florida, were outstanding in these matches and captured first and second prizes. Good shooting was done by all who participated and while the officers of the Border Patrol who took part fell far short of their accomplishments in the matches of the previous year, at the same time, they did good shooting.

It seems that a large sum of money was appropriated at Miami which enabled Police officers in that city to engage in much practice shooting prior to the matches and as a result they carried home with them most of the medals.

The Border Patrol officers hope to do better next year if they are able to participate in the matches.
