During the recent trip of inspection by Supervisor Kelly, a considerable number of patrol inspectors made inquiry as to whether authority could be obtained for patrol inspectors wearing slacks during the summer months, and Mr. Kelly made the suggestion that a vote be taken of the patrol inspectors; that the months be limited to June, July and August; and that it be made plain to the patrol inspectors that the slacks would have to be kept pressed and in good condition at all times.

The result of this vote is as follows:
