It being thought that matter contained therein may be of interest to you in connection with the training and instructing of new Border Patrol appointees in your own district, there are being enclosed copies of the subject outline, schedule of instruction covering the first two periods of the course, and outlines of various of the lectures being given at the training school for new Patrol officers of District No. 17 being held at Patrol subdistrict headquarters at El Paso, Texas.

It is desired that you advise this office what methods are being pursued in the training of new patrol inspectors in your district and what effort is being made to acquaint them with the laws and their enforcement. Incidents come to the attention of the Central Office not infrequently which would appear to indicate that Patrol officers have not been adequately trained or instructed for the various phases of the work upon which they are engaged, and the importance of giving Patrol officers the right kind of instruction while they are yet new in the Service can not be too greatly stressed.

This office will be glad to have an expression of your views, together with any suggestions which you have to offer.
