Reference being had to the Central Office's letter of April 20 approving the challenge issued by the Tampa, Florida border patrol subdistrict for a four-man team pistol match, the following scores, which were submitted by the subdistricts accepting the challenge, are announced.

All of the scores submitted are considered excellent, and this is particularly true of those made by some of the teams which, it will be noted, fired the prescribed courses with the Service Issue 45 calibre revolvers. The spirit in which the matches were carried out, and the good sportsmanship in evidence was as much a source of gratification to the Central Office as the proficiency with firearms which has been shown. The Tampa subdistrict, which made fourth place in the match, undoubtedly robbed itself of a chance for a higher place by reason of the fact that District Supervisor Courtney, who was Chief Patrol Inspector of the Tampa subdistrict at the time the challenge was issued, considered himself ineligible to compete and did not take his usual place on the team because of his promotion.


