QUESTION XXIV

In approximately how many cases during the past year has the Immigration Border Patrol acted on requests from the Bureau of Investigation relative to the apprehension of a criminal wanted by the Bureau? In how many of these cases did the Patrol apprehend or assist in the apprehension of the wanted criminal?

There is no record maintained of the number of requests received from the Bureau of Investigation for the apprehension of criminals. Bulletins of criminals wanted are received regularly and are circularized to the Immigration Patrol Officers.

As indicated in the extracts from District reports, covered by the answers to Questions 22, 23, and 27, the Bureau of Investigation, Department of Justice, has enlisted the assistance and cooperation of the Immigration Border Patrol in notorious kidnaping cases.
