MEMORANDUM:

Estimate for subdistrict headquarters buildings, Northern Border.

Lynden, Wash., Bonners Ferry, Idaho, Havre, Montana.

Grand Forks, N. D. Buffalo, N.Y.*

These buildings are to be similar to Plan "D" for Del Rio, Texas, except to have basement for heating plant and fuel storage.

The buildings are to be approximately 45 x 49 feet, with porch, and the cost is estimated to be as follows:
