Forms I-45, I-45A and I-45B

Attached is a folder which was received from Mr. Williams' office containing proposed instructions concerning Forms I-45, I-45A and I-45B. I feel that the instructions should be amended as follows:

Part 150 I, section 3, penultimate sentence:

Only those persons released as United States citizens, as aliens not subject to deportation, or as pending adjustment of status shall be shown as released.

Section 150.1 III, section 1, first sentence:

An immigrant inspector or officer acting as such shall, whenever practicable, use Form I-45A or I-45B for the purpose of securing a preliminary statement as to immigration status.

Third and fourth sentences:

The pronouns in Form I-45B need not be changed regardless of the sex or number of persons involved.

Will you kindly let me know whether the proposed instructions, with the amendments noted, meet with your approval and if not, what further changes you recommend, returning the enclosure with your memorandum.
