

SUBJECT: American Revolution Bicentennial Celebration Material

To continue and increase the Service's participation in the Revolution Bicentennial Celebration during Calendar Year 1976, the following items will be provided in the near future to all offices.

1. Official Bicentennial decals for use on (INS vehicles (windows) and on) office windows and doors, Style M-6, size 6 1/2 x 6 1/2, two sided "We Salute."
2. Vehicle bumper decals, style TR, size 4 3/4 x 17 1/2", "We Salute."
3. Letterhead Stationery with the Bicentennial logo.
4. Other uses of (the official Bicentennial logo such as on uniforms, Service forms, naturalization certificates and on flyers for distribution with other material are under consideration and information will be furnished as received. It is not intended that decals and bumper stickers be placed on undercover vehicles.
