



Subject - Complete the state of Subject Bicycle/Boat Patrol Uniform Policy

To All Chief Patrol Agents All Associate Chiefs (ROBORS):

From Headquarters Border Patrol

Southern Northern Eastern Western

A modification to the Border Patrol rough duty uniform has been approved for use, at the Chief Patrol Agents' discretion, during bicycle and boat patrol activities. The composition of the basic uniform for both activities is as follows:

BOAT PATROL

Rough duty shirt Rough duty trousers (hemmed to three inches above the knee) Rough duty cap Black nylon webbed utility gear White crew length socks (Optional) Deck shoes

BICYCLE PATROL

Rough duty shirt Rough duty trousers (hemmed to three inches above the knee) Rough duty cap Black nylon webbed utility gear White crew length socks Black low quarters or 3/4 high sneaker type shoes Black bicycle shorts Bicycle helmet Bicycle gloves (Optional)

Bicycle shorts shall only be worn under the rough duty trousers and shall not be visible below the hem of the trousers.

All uniformed officers of a detail shall be dressed alike.

If the Chief Patrol Agent authorizes the use of the modified rough duty uniform for bicycle or boat patrol, the uniform items must be provided to the affected employees.
