Commissioner's Integrity Award	*	A legacy U.S. Customs to recognize an employee who clearly demonstrated work habits and devotion to integrity that are above reproach and exemplified CBP's core values and ethical standards while on duty (e.g., participated in an undercover operation, which led to the arrest of an individual or addressed a potential incident of terrorism or corruption).
Commissioner's Humanitarian Award Commissioner's Exceptional		A legacy U.S. Customs award to recognize heroic or selfless acts performed while on or off duty - demonstrating compassion and competence, exceeding normal expectations, in assisting individuals in extreme circumstances. A legacy U.S. Customs recognition used to represent numerous, named Commissioner's Awards, e.g. the Mission Integration Award, the Law Enforcement Officer Award, the
Service Award Commissioner's Blue Eagle	*	Ambassador Award, the EEO/Diversity Award and many others. A legacy U.S. Customs award to recognize individual(s) for a single, specific enforcement action with a significant enforcement result(s).
Award Commissioner's Unit Citation	UNIT	A legacy U.S. Customs award to recognize a group of individuals whose performance as a unit exceeds quantity and quality of normal requirements.
Operation Secure Line	SECURE	OFO Award - Presented to employees, both organic and on temporary detail that supported Operation Secure Line. The citation bar will be awarded based on the below criteria: Have served in good standing; Have been assigned for a period of 30 days or longer, and/or; Performed activities in direct support of the operation.

USBP Newton-Azrak Award	-	May be awarded to any USBP employee who performs a conspicuous act of heroism: The act performed must be above and beyond the call of duty. The act performed must present an imminent and personal danger to the life of the individual. The individual must have knowledge of the risks involved and voluntarily assume them.
USBP Purple Cross Award		The May be awarded to any employee who, while in the scope of duty, sustains: Protracted or permanent impairment of any bodily function; Fatal injury; Injury as the result of an assault with a deadly weapon, which requires treatment by a medical professional; or Injuries attributed, directly or indirectly, from an attack by an assailant with the following factors: The injury or wound cannot be attributed to bravado or gross negligence; and Any act of valor may be distinguished with the addition of a "V" device to affix to the ribbon. The nomination must convey the veracity of the claim.
USBP Commendation Award		 Awarded to an employee or a group for exceptional meritorious achievement or service. The acts or services must be accomplished or performed in a manner above that normally expected, and sufficient to distinguish the recipient(s) above those performing similar services, or Awarded to an individual for extraordinary heroism, not justifying the Newton-Azrak Award, or Awarded to a group for extraordinary heroism.
USBP Achievement Award		 Awarded to an employee or a group for meritorious achievement or service based on sustained performance or specific achievement of a superlative nature, and shall be of such merit as to warrant more recognition than is possible by nontraditional awards, but which is not significant enough to justify the U.S. Border Patrol Commendation Award, or Awarded to an individual or a group for heroism, not justifying the U.S. Border Patrol Commendation Award.
USBP 75th Anniversary Commemorative Award	■ 1084-1000	 Awarded to every Border Patrol Agent and Aircraft Pilot serving on and immediately before May 28, 1999.
